

Cambridge Exam Courses (FCE & CAE)

This is a combined programme that offers students the opportunity to improve their knowledge of English and prepare for one of the higher level Cambridge exams.

At CELT we prepare students for both the First Certificate in English (FCE) and the Certificate in Advanced English (CAE).

FCE is an examination at upper-intermediate level and is classified as level B2 of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR) while CAE is a high level qualification classified as level C1.

Both FCE and CAE exams have five papers:

- Reading
- Writing
- Use of English
- Listening
- Speaking



Successful candidates will receive a certificate awarded by the University of Cambridge ESOL Examinations, which is recognised by universities and employers throughout the world.

You will also receive a statement of results, showing how you performed in each of the five papers.

Our Preparation Course

On this programme, students are given thorough preparation for the FCE & CAE exams. All students have a total of 22 hours of tuition per week which consists of 16 hours of general English during the mornings and 6 hours of exam practice in the afternoons.

The afternoon programme aims to give students guidance and practice in all 5 areas of the exam (reading, writing, use of English, listening and speaking) with assessment and feedback from our teachers on all work produced. The course helps students familiarise themselves with the format of the exam and develop their exam techniques.

By the end of the course students will have improved their general command of English, increased their vocabulary and will feel prepared for their chosen examination.

Cambridge examinations take place several times a year in the UK. We are happy to help students enrol for these exams at the local open centre in Cardiff or at other exam centres around the country.
